Though it contains a record of two other groups of people who once lived in the Americas, it is for the most part a record of the people of Nephi.

The Messages so often mentioned in this publication are messages from the Lord, brought to earth by his chosen servant John the Baptist, who comes to earth in a glorified body to finish the work given him of God; that of restoring all things (Matthew 17:11). The angel first came in 1829 and restored the priesthood authority of the Son of God, that The Church of Christ might be established as in the days of the Apostles.

In 1927, the angel messenger again appeared, and on numerous subsequent visits, has brought to us The Word of the Lord that the Church of Christ might be set in order, that a people might be prepared to be the bride of Christ. This "The Elijah Message" so many have looked for, "The midnight cry" has been proclaimed, a warning of destruction, but to the people of the Lord, a message that Christ's coming is near at hand. Fear God and give glory to his name, for the hour of his judgment has come. Awake thou that sleep and arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light.

We hope that whosoever reads these pages might make it a matter of prayer and fasting in humility before God, that they may know for themselves, that God has again spoken and revealed His will from Heaven. To this end we dedicate *The Assured Way*.

was trying to decide whether to take a job in China. There were so many things leading up to this in her life and it seemed to drop into her life. Roadblocks went away and now she had to decide. She would have to leave everything. She chose to go. We kept in touch and have been talking for a few months. One day she was waiting for a visa. I'm easy going and flexible. Not as structured as she is. She is stressing about visa. I told her if you knew God's plan it would probably drive you insane. Sometimes it is years in the making for one moment. He has this under control. Sit back and let God be God. Visa came and all was well.

That is how it works. If we knew everything He had set up for us we would probably try to help Him out. Then we would mess it up. We would be in the way. The hardest part is to be still. Romans 5:1-5 When faith becomes perfect knowledge it is not faith anymore it is knowledge. That is how this work is. As God writes the truthfulness of it on our hearts and we walk in the way we know it to be true. We know He will send His messenger because His work has been proven to be true over and over again. Question – of the names mentioned in the messenger did everyone mentioned know that they were called whether the accepted their

calling or not.

Terry – to our knowledge everyone was known by someone in the church at the time and given the opportunity to be a part of the work. Some did not ever come into the church and be a part. Even in the latter messages some were called but chose not to accept their calling. As an example in the 117th Jerome Williams wanted no part of the work. Some accepted but then didn't stay in work.

Back in the 30's there was more fertile ground because of the state the nation was in. They had to rely on the Lord.

I think if someone tells the Lord he can be used. God checks out our sincerity in that. Knowing some won't know and some won't stay. Message 116 This was the last straw that broke the camels back that led into 1994 people leaving. We are going to study to see that God is good to His word and that He doesn't change. Men might, but God doesn't Message 117:2, 119:6

There was evil that had to be cleansed. That is why in Romans in verse 3 it says that glory in tribulations

knowing it worketh patience. Do we have the patience to wait on God. We spoke of this earlier in the week and Darren did too. People lost their first love and it became regulation and not salvation. That is what happened with the building of the temple as well. People were bickering and not preaching gospel. We have talked about that in other services Christ was our perfect example. We know Him to be the son of God and the Son of man. John recognized him and thought Christ should be baptizing him. But Christ had to be baptized to fulfill His Word. John was filled with the spirit in his mothers womb. That is why he recognized Him. Even John got discouraged. He sent his followers to ask Christ "are you the real Messiah". Christ told them to show John of Christ's works. It was part of His work he had to do.

When you look at the work and the gospel. Look at the authority. Who are we to think we have more authority than His. Hebrews 6:1-2 The Lord teaches that we have to remember to preach the whole plan. There were men seeking to be prominent at the time. They were competing to be more righteous than others. This was in the ministry. We can't allow that to happen again. Larry and Norm are dealing with something in India where a man had lost track of his responsibility and his first love. It had to be corrected. A week later everything was firmed up the Lord brought people into the work. Needed to be cleansed first. The reward we want is from God not being the best at something. We set up others for failure when we start praising them. When someone is used by God to do a good work then people start looking up to him/her and not God. Other times people stop believing in the work because they take offense at someone getting credit. It is easy to forget the simple commands of God. When we do what this verse says it is when we know that the Lord has his hand on the situation. The Lord does more than we are expecting sometimes. We talked about this before. When you talk about pace it is a speed. A way of progress. He can

not change that pace now. He isn't going to change how he calls people into the quorums because the pace is set that they will be called by the messenger in the message. If the authority is established there can only be one church. People can't break off and make their own church and claim the authority. He does not want us to compromise to get along. In 1929 the 12th message the temple lot took all of the property. But left the authority. We have to have the patience to wait on God. Message 107:5&6 We have to get waiting upon the Lord to be muscle memory.

When this first came out people thought it was about neat in outward appearance. He is telling us we are the Lord's body act like it. It says lifestyle. People say they are representing Christ but their life doesn't show it. Willingness to hear still small voice. I was in my truck bunk pleading with God over what was going on in church. I heard the Lord say "I have this" at that time the spirit washed over me like warm oil from head to toe. From that night on I've had no fear of His work succeeding.

3 Nephi 27:1-10 Lots of churches call themselves the church of Christ but are they built on His gospel? The catholic church's official name is church of Christ. We know it is not built on His gospel.

John 1:1-5 the lightness was given so that the standard might be set. When man is left to his own devices we get steered away. We are told to preserve the standard and keep it sacred. He had rejected all creeds and factions of men. That is because they had added things to make it so that people liked it. It was all out of wack.

Message 74:3-4 we did a lot of traveling to let people know what was happening in church. Ed and I went to Durant. We had not discussed what we were going to say or talk about. More than visiting as friends. There was no strategic planning. He taught Sunday school that morning and he opened up with the 74th message and it was the same one that I had been reading and studying to talk about. This was in 1994. This lays out that the choice you make is yours but do you stay the course or not. I want to talk about that the truth shall go on to its mission. The honest of heart are seeing it and will see it.

It is there to be seen by all. Our responsibility is to take it in its fullness to the brethren of the world that they might be brethren with us. Christ said there are multitudes waiting. He is going to bring them in and they have to be steadfast and loyal. His church has to be ready. We are seeing God doing a good work. 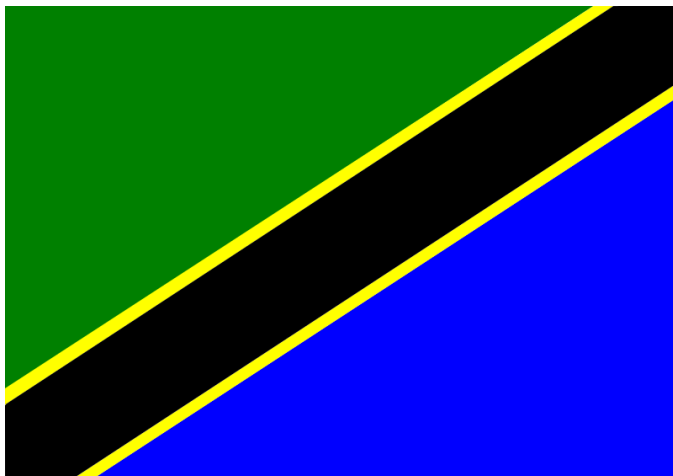

This is Tuesday August 25th and we are in Tanzania. We left Kenya at 2:30am this morning. Brother Norm, Fred, Peter and myself. We arrived at the border around 9:30am.

There we took food before crossing into Tanzania. We got through Immigration with no problems. We then started the first leg of our journey to the town of Musamo. We arrived around 3pm and were met there by

our Brother Masatu. We then took public transportation to his home. We arrived at his home about 7:30pm. We were greeted by his family and a number of the Saints. After greetings we were served tea and supper. It was a long day for us. Just a little tired. Hot water was made and we were able to take showers which were nice to remove some of the dust from the trip. After showers we moved over to where we would be lodging while in that area. To our surprise it was the same place we stayed in 2010 while in Tanzania.

This is Wednesday morning August 26th, we are up around 7:30am, and it is a lovely day. We sat outside on the rocks wrote a little in our journals. Around 9am we had breakfast. Around 10:30 am services begin with the teaching of the foundation of Christ Church. Brother Norman began the teaching on the Foundation. There were a number of Saints there along with Elders and Disciples, and some visitors. The service went well thanks to our Lord. There were questions and answers after the teachings. We had a full day with the Saints. It ended around



6:30pm. Being in an area where there is no electric, night teaching is a little tough. Supper was served about 7pm and after that, it was showers and sleep.

Thursday August 27th 2015, this is a beautiful day in the Lord and we praise Him for letting us witness another day. Today we continued with study on the word of God, explaining what the Lord is saying today to His people and the world. He does not change and He is speaking to us today. The second half of the day Brother Norm taught on the second coming of Christ. The Lord blessed this day and we thank Him with all our hearts.

Friday August 28th another wonderful day, bright sun and a breeze from the N. E. Today one of the visitors by the name of Abraham asked for baptism and we learned that his wife also would be baptized. They were baptized in Lake Victoria. Brother Abraham was called as a Disciple in the Church. He accepted and was ordained by Brother Norm and me.

Today Saturday we are to leave for Mwanza but before

we leave we must serve the Lords supper to the Saints. Service got on the way around 9am and all went well and we were on our way to Mwanza around 12:30am. It was a blessed service. As always it was not easy leaving, but we had to move on for the Lord. We arrived in Musumi around 4pm. There we took lunch. At 6:30pm we departed for Mwanza, there we have a Local.
