Two Deadly Sins

Apostle Norman Lyles

Let the Assured Way continue to reach out unto the nations, that all may be blessed and encouraged. — Mess. 123:19

One of the more interesting stories the Lord placed in His Word for us to understand and be guided by; is contained in the 13th chapter of 1st kings. There are many lessons and ways to find guidance for our lives in the thirteenth chapter. Probably one of the more important lessons comes in the understanding of the two deadly sins: Doubt and Disobedience.

The lesson begins in verse one wherein it is said, “Behold, there came a man of God out of Judah by the Word of the Lord unto Beth-el and Jeroboam stood by the altar to burn incense.”

It is easy to miss the purpose of the man of God, however with a careful reading; we discover his movements were by the Word of the Lord. He wasn’t moving on his own will or his own thoughts, rather at the direction and the Word of the Lord.

The Lord had sent him to prophesy and this he did in verse 2, saying: **“thus saith the Lord: Behold a child shall be born unto the house of David, Josiah by name, and upon thee shall he offer the priests of the high places that burn incense upon thee, and men’s bones shall be burnt upon thee.”** The man of God continued in His prophesy and said in verse three, **“This shall be a sign which the Lord hath spoken; Behold, the altar shall be rent, and the ashes that are upon it shall be poured out.”**

Now the king was unhappy and displeased with the prophesy and he put forth his hand from the altar and said lay hold on him. And his hand, which he had put forth against the man of God, dried up, so that he could not pull it again to him. Then the altar was rent, and the ashes poured out from the altar, according to the sign, which the man of God had given by the Word of the Lord. We find the doubts of the king had dire results and caused his hand to be withered.

The King then asked the man of God to restore his hand to normal and the man of God did restore the Kings hand to normal. The king was of course grateful and requested the man of God to come home with him and he would reward the man of God; however the man of God said, **“If thou will give me half thine house, I will not go in with thee, neither will I eat bread nor drink water in this place.”** **“For it was charged me by the Word of the Lord, saying, eat no bread, nor drink water, nor turn again by the same way that thou camest.”**

The man of God did not doubt the Lord, nor would he disobey what the Lord had sent him to do and how he was to do it. Try to keep in mind dear friends: it is not so simple to ignore a king, or to turn away from the King and go your way as the Lord had commanded him to do.

The lesson continues and we find the man of God on his way is greeted by an old prophet who had found him under a tree (no doubt weary and tired and hungry from his journey). We find in verses 15- 19, the following: **“come home with me and eat bread. And he said, I may not return with thee, nor go in with thee, neither will I eat bread nor drink water with thee in this place. For it was said to me by the Word of the Lord, Thou shall eat no bread, nor drink water there, nor return again to go by the way that thou camest.”**

It is very plain the man of God knew what the Word of the Lord had commanded him to do and he was determined to obey the Lord. He did not doubt what the Word of the Lord had said unto him and he certainly was of a mind to obey that, which had been commanded by the Word of the Lord.

In verses 18-19 we find, **“He said unto him, I am a prophet also as thou art and an angel spake unto me by the word of the Lord, saying bring him back with thee unto**

In its pages are found the thoughts and expressions of a united people, whose only aim is to promote the cause of Christ by spreading abroad to every nation, tongue, and people, the true gospel of Christ, that through obedience to his laws we might be found worthy of eternal life.

In this publication, The Record of the Nephites is quoted many times. This book was revealed and translated by the gift and power of God: The year 1828 marked the beginning of the restoration of all things. It is a history of the people who once lived in the Americas, some who are the ancestors of the Native America Indians. Though it contains a record of two other groups of people who once lived in the Americas, it is for the most part a record of the people of Nephi.

The Messages so often mentioned in this publication are messages from the Lord, brought to earth by his chosen servant John the Baptist, who comes to earth in a glorified body to finish the work given him of God; that of restoring all things (Matthew 17:11). The angel first came in 1829 and restored the priesthood authority of the Son of God, that The Church of Christ might be established as in the days of the Apostles.

thine house, that he may eat bread and drink water, but he lied to unto him. So he went back with him, and did eat bread in his house, and drink water.”

Please keep in mind that indeed the old prophet was a true prophet, as we shall discover later, and the man of God understood the old prophet was a true prophet.

However, at this point we must ask ourselves a very important question: Does God Change? What God has said, does it change or is it forever? Perhaps you, yourself today are pondering a decision of what you should or should not do. Perhaps you have a close and dear friend who you have no doubt is a fellow Christian, perhaps even a prophet and they are telling you something that is perhaps slightly different than what the Word of God has already told you. Perhaps it is even an Angel who speaks unto you and tells you to do something different than the Word of God has told you to do. Does the Word of God change? Does God change?

In verses 20-26 we find the wages of doubt and disobedience: **“And it came to pass, as they sat at the table, that the Word of the Lord came unto the prophet that brought him back: and he cried unto the man of God that came from Judah, saying thus saith the Lord, Forasmuch as thou hast disobeyed the mouth of the Lord, and hast not kept the commandment which the Lord thy God commanded thee, But camest back and hast eaten bread and drunk water in the place of which the lord did say to thee, eat no bread, and drink no water, thy carcass shall not come unto the sepul-**

cher of thy fathers. And it came to pass, after he had eaten bread, and after he had drunk that he saddled for him the ass, to wit, for the prophet whom he had brought back. And when he was gone, a lion met him by the way, and slew him; and his carcass was cast in the way, and the ass stood by it, the lion also stood by the carcass. Behold men passed by, and saw the carcass cast in the way, and the lion standing by the carcass, and they came and told it in the city where the old prophet dwelt. And the prophet that brought him back from the way heard thereof, he said, it is the man of God, who was disobedient unto the Word of the Lord.”

Message 74:2-4 said, **“Will the people of the Lord heed the warning and obey the instructions I bring from the Lord, your God that there may be a bride prepared and the way of deliverance established, that mankind may learn of the way of the Lord, His Words, in these last days. The Lord has sent me with a message when the hearts of the people were bleeding. I have come to minister that comfort may come to all who will walk uprightously in this way. All that I have brought and will bring comes from the Lord your God. The Lord has looked upon His Church to bless the faithful. Some have denied the Lord and His goodness; some are full of doubt and are deprived of the joys of the Lord. Some will repent, others will go to destruction.”**

The Lord stated long ago the primary purpose of the Church is Missionary. Jesus Christ in Matthew chapter twenty-eight said for His Apostles to go to the world and teach and Baptize in the name of the

Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. God has never changed nor will He.

Two of the deadliest sins are doubt and disobedience. God has not always promised safety, or success; in fact, He told his original Apostles they would be hated, hunted, and even killed for His name’s sake. He did promise also however He would always be with us, even unto the end of the world.

Message 129 (the Word of God), said in verse 21, **“It is the Lord’s Will and plan that while there is yet time, He send forth the two Apostles unto the world to fulfill His Plan and Authority. Indeed the time is short before the folding in of the Great Tribulation and in spite of the great dangers that are present, the Lord shall send His Angels before these men as they labor at His direction and His time at His instruction. The Lord has prepared their hearts and their souls and His Power shall be upon them. It is the Lord’s Will Apostle Norman D. Lyles and Apostle Larry Gosier Williams move unto the Philippines, India, Africa, and England early in 2021 to carry the Lord’s Word and provide necessary guidance, corrections, instructions, and bring forth understanding among the Churches in those nations.”**

It is in obedience unto the Word of the Lord, the church has commissioned this journey which will be departing on January 27, 2021 and we request your prayer and support, as your representatives and brothers move out among the nations. God Bless you all.

The Message of Christ Today

Message 121

The Messenger of the Lord appeared unto me at the Buracho Local in Kenya on September 29, 2018 at 5am and was with me a little over an hour. I was sitting on a rock writing in my journal the events of the past few days of our missionary effort in Uganda and Kenya.

It was just becoming slightly light enough for me to see and write, when suddenly the Angel, John the Baptist, stood before me. I, at first thought it was a vision, until he reached in my pack, which was beside me, and handed me a writing pad and another pen and commanded me to write the Message that he had brought unto me from the Lord Christ Jesus. All my doubts and fears vanished and a great peace came over me, as he moved his hand to my head.

He wore a robe of white, and appeared to be about six foot tall, and perhaps 30 years of age, with a beard and hair down to his shoulder. Most noticeable were his eyes, which seemed to pierce my very soul and his appearance seemed to radiate light. His voice was deep and seemingly kind. — Norman Lyles

1) I have come to you from the Lord, from His Presence. Write what I shall give you to instruct the direct the Work of the Lord. Fear not the words of men whose hearts are carnal and seek their own glory. It is Satan who has sought to destroy the Work and Word of God. I am the resurrected John the Baptist, the Messenger of the Covenant.

2) I have come unto you with the Word of the Lord. A message unto the people of God. You are to give it to your brethren and the Church.

3) With hold not the Word of the Lord from His People; for the Lord hath sent His Messenger with words of life for the people of the Lord.

4) I have come unto you with the Word and Will of the Lord. There are those who have spoken words not from the Lord; appointing and purporting to call men into the ministry; yet they are like vessels empty of water;

16) The Lord is pleased with the work of Josphat Wanjala, Tom Matakwa, Joseph Juan, Jerry Juan, and Amos Mutibo.

17) It is the Lord's Will these be ordained as Bishops: Chris Laws, Gary Doudy, Bill Holden, and John Githinji of Africa. Let Jai Singh of India prepare to be a Bishop, and the Lord will use him to be a blessing to many. The Lord has seen the humility and the heart of Scott Lyles; let him be restored as Bishop in the Church of Christ with the Elijah Message.

18) The Work in the foreign fields has been pleasing unto the Lord, and is held in due respect: the work of Edward Coffey, Apostle Norman Don Lyles, and Apostle Larry Gosier Williams. Therefore, let Apostle Norman Don Lyles and Apostle Larry Gosier Williams continue to cover the work in the foreign fields.

Letters from the Vineyard

God has taken me down many paths in my life, few of which were particularly planned or expected. I have learned to know that whatever I plan will seldom turn out the way I planned it but my prayer is that it will turn out in such a way that the Lord is honored. Five years ago we felt led to begin the process of remodeling a building to open a restaurant and flower shop.

It took us 3 long years to do the remodeling work which was done mostly by ourselves and our family. It was a labor of love and we were blessed in the process. God allowed us to spend time together, explore possibilities, and learn numerous skills. He also kept us safe in some unsafe circumstances. There was much prayer involved in this process, much of it for his protection in the work.

Finally, in November of 2017 we opened to the public. We had known that it would be a tremendous amount of work but were unaware of how much emotional work it would be. While Terry worked at a regular job in the local hospital I did my best to run the business. As usual nothing went as planned. Business was not as predicted. The staff came and went. The hours we planned were not what the community needed.

Every morning we got up and went to work and did everything we could think of to make it work. We cried, prayed, talked to the public and tried new things. And everyday we praised God for the business and the ability to serve him. A couple of times we thought that the end had come but each time he had different plans. From the beginning I have learned spiritual lessons that before the business I would

not have expected to need to learn. I have learned to accept things as they come not just as I want them. I have learned to appreciate people who support me. Not only by doing business but also and most importantly by lifting me up and encouraging me. I praise God for each of those people. Many times I have questioned the wisdom of the decision to start this business even though I have from the beginning maintained to all who would listen that I believe God put me here.

I believe it can be a mechanism for me to honor him and spread his gospel. I am afraid that I have not succeeded in that as well as I would like but I continue to strive to do so. I have tried to give him the glory for all things.

One thing that I have had to learn is to not be discouraged or to question God. I often question my powers of discernment but not my belief that he is guiding me. I have become very aware that it is very important to Praise God in all things. Not just when it is blatantly obvious that he is with me but more importantly when I am wondering where he is. I have learned that anyone can praise him when things are going great but it is harder and more important when they are not.

We used to feel like we could never be away from the business at the same time. When Assembly came only Terry went because we were afraid of the consequences of us both being gone. Then in 2019 the Messenger came and stated that we needed to go to the Assembly and we realized we had to learn to trust him more and that if he instructed us to do something and we obeyed he would honor that and take care

of us. That year I went some. This year I was in attendance for the whole time. It was not easy being gone and things did not all go well. We are not sure at this writing how many repercussions there will be but we are sure that when God tells us to do something, he will be with us when we do. The reward might or might not include monetary aspects but for sure it will involve his peace if we allow it. We can be assured that there will be blessings of his choice not ours.

In my life time I have not had any major life-threatening challenges. I have not had a great many deaths to endure. Compared to most my trials have been small and many self-induced. However, we are not judged by the size of our trials but rather our reaction to them.
