Grace by Faith

Let the Assured Way continue to reach out unto the nations, that all may be blessed and encouraged. — Mess. 123:19

“Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.” Romans 5:1-2;

The Apostle Paul in his Epistle to the Romans stated plainly that we have access to Grace by faith. In other words, we lay hold on salvation and the grace of God which covers our sins through faith on the word of God. Now faith is not just belief. Belief is the first fruits of faith, but belief must be exercised to become faith. For the word of God says that Abraham’s faith was counted unto him for righteousness. He was counted RIGHTEOUS or he was JUSTIFIED because of His faith in the word of God.

“What shall we say then that Abraham our father, as pertaining to the flesh, hath found? For if Abraham were justified by works, he hath whereof to glory; but not before God. For what saith the scripture? Abraham believed God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness.” Romans 4:1-3;

Now most people stop at the 3rd verse of Romans Chapter 4; but we must read on to fully understand what Paul was saying.

“Now to him that worketh is the reward not reckoned of grace, but of debt. But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness.” Romans 4:5-6;

Notice that the word says if we were able to earn salvation then it is not grace but a debt that is owed to us, but because we cannot earn salvation it is only through grace and mercy that we obtain salvation. And we can only gain access to this grace by FAITH. The word says that we must first believe on Him who justifieth the ungodly. Only Christ Jesus can justify the ungodly. Christ alone

fulfilled the Law and satisfied the demands of Justice as our perfect example when He died on the cross for our sins and was resurrected the third day. And when we believe on Him, we begin the process of having faith, but then we must continue on to solidify and crystallize that belief into true Faith. We solidify our belief unto faith when we have the confidence in the word of God to begin to exercise it and step out on it in obedience, while still trusting that it will uphold us and perform according to the promises of God.

“For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.” – Ephesians 2:8-9;

Only by exercising faith in the word of God can we obtain eternal life in Christ Jesus. Because Christ gave His life that mankind might be brought back into the presence of God. And Salvation is a free gift that our Savior desires that all would freely accept, but it is only accessible through faith in the word of God. In the natural world we all understand accessibility. In order to enter into a building or a house you must have a means of accessibility. You need a way to gain access to the inside of the building. Or in other words, a way of moving from outside of the house to inside of the house. A door is the most common way of gaining access to a building. You simply walk up to the door and open it and it grants you access into the building. If I stand outside of the building and never use the door I can never enter into the building. And no matter how much I may want to go inside the building, if I do not walk up to the door and open it and walk in then I cannot gain access. But if I walk to the door and open it and walk inside, I can easily gain access to the inside of the building. So, it is with the Kingdom of God. If we desire to enter into His king-

FOREWORD

The Assured Way, the official publication of THE CHURCH OF CHRIST WITH THE ELIJAH MESSAGE inc. comes to you as an expression of hope we have in Christ.

In its pages are found the thoughts and expressions of a united people, whose only aim is to promote the cause of Christ by spreading abroad to every nation, tongue, and people, the true gospel of Christ, that through obedience to his laws we might be found worthy of eternal life.

In this publication, The Record of the Nephites is quoted many times. This book was revealed and translated by the gift and power of God: The year 1828 marked the beginning of the restoration of all things. It is a history of the people who once lived in the Americas, some who are the ancestors of the Native America Indians. Though it contains a record of two other groups of people who once lived in the Americas, it is for the most part a record of the people of Nephi.

The Messages so often mentioned in this publication are messages from the Lord, brought to earth by his chosen servant John the Baptist, who comes to earth in a glorified body to finish the work given him of God; that of restoring all things (Matthew 17:11). The angel first came in 1829 and restored the priesthood authority of the Son of God, that The Church of Christ might be established as in the days of the Apostles.

In 1927, the angel messenger again appeared, and on numerous subsequent visits, has brought to us The Word of the Lord that the Church of Christ might be set in order, that a people might be prepared to be the bride of Christ. This "The Elijah Message" so many have looked for, "The midnight cry" has been proclaimed, a warning of destruction, but to the people of the Lord, a message that Christ's coming is near at hand. Fear God and give glory to his name, for the hour of his judgment has come. Awake thou that sleep and arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light.

We hope that whosoever reads these pages might make it a matter of prayer and fasting in humility before God, that they may know for themselves, that God has again spoken and revealed His will from Heaven. To this end we dedicate *The Assured Way*.

dom and sup with Him, we must first gain access into His Kingdom through the door. That access is granted when we exercise faith on the word of God. The Bible tells us we must be born of the water and the spirit to gain access into the kingdom of God, but if I only believe and never exercise the faith to repent and receive baptism and have the hands laid on my head for the gift and gifts of the Holy Spirit then I will never gain access to the Grace of God which is by faith.

“Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born? Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.” -- John 3:3-5;

Now Abraham is known as the father of the faithful because he was obedient to the word of God. But he first had to believe on the word of God before he could exercise faith on the word. And His belief led him to step out on the word as he moved from belief to firm faith in action. He had belief and a hope that the word was true so he began to try the word through action and obedience.

“Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.” -- Hebrews 11:1;

We know that faith is not a perfect knowledge, because if we know something then there is no need for faith or belief. Because we know it and there is no opportunity for faith. But if we believe in something then we have a hope that it is true. And if we continue to hope then we begin to gain confidence and confidence leads us to take action because of our hope in the word of God. And then our actions which are based on our hope and confidence

in His word becomes firm faith. And through our faith which is brought about by our actions through the hope of His word we begin to access Grace. And if we continue in our faith and endure until the end then our faith will be rewarded with Eternal life in Christ.

So, then we are justified by our faith and not because of our belief alone. Belief is the first step to obtaining faith, because we must first hear the word in order to believe and then we can begin to hope which will bring us the confidence to take action. And action becomes faith when it is seasoned with the spirit of God. **“So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.” -- Romans 10:17;**

Once we hear the word of God then we have an opportunity to believe it. And if we believe it, then we have the opportunity to have hope in its truthfulness. And that hope should bring us to begin to have confidence and we express that confidence in our actions which brings us to faith. And it is impossible to please God without faith.

“But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.” -- Hebrews 11:6;

So, now we begin to understand that the only way we can lay hold on salvation is through the Grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, but without faith we cannot obtain that Grace. And faith as was seen by the Actions of Abraham is not only belief in the word of God, but it is obedience to the word of God. Because Abraham not only believed God, but he was moved to action because of his belief. And that belief became faith when he took action to accomplish the things God instructed him to do. God fulfilled his promises to Abraham not because of his belief alone, but because of his faith in God's word.

“For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, was not to

Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.” -- Romans 4:13;

And we know that God is unchangeable and without respect of persons, so he will likewise fulfill all of His promises to those that are faithful to His word in obedience just as he fulfilled his promises to Abraham. So, let us **“press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus”**, by striving to be faithful servants obedient to the word of God in all that He has called us to do. We must work to share the Gospel of Christ to a lost and a fallen world.

“Much is folly before me and man is nothing of good when he heeds not my voice. Know ye the witness of my Spirit, how that it caused the hearts of men to mellow before me. Is this Spirit still with you? Heed ye the still small voice and the promptings of the divine Spirit. Be not conformed to the works of darkness nor the ways of the world. Work with an eye single to my glory; when I speak answer by your actions; abide in my doctrine; let your words and deeds be that to my honor and glory. Return your love and service to me that your works may show your faith.” -- Mess. 31:8;

“This is the sifting time. Men's hearts will be tried, but those that have faith in God, and will follow the instructions given, will be blessed.” -- Mess.18:6;

“Let your faith be strong in the Lord your God. Read the eleventh chapter of Hebrews. Read it often. By faith you shall do your work. Send this message to your brethren. Some will believe it, but some will not believe. Nevertheless, it will strengthen others; but inasmuch as you and your brethren are humble and faithful to your trust, God will bless your work.” -- Mess. 7&8:11;

The Message of Christ Today

Message 125

The Messenger of the Lord, the Elijah, the resurrected John the Baptist, appeared to me in my home on June 7th, 2019 at 1:20 in the afternoon. I was studying and preparing for the coming general Assembly of the Church of Christ with the Elijah Message later this month. For several days I had felt the Spirit of the Lord in great measure and felt the Messenger John the Baptist would come soon.

He opened my front door and came up the stairs into my living room, as I sat reading my Bible on the sofa. He smiled and greeted me in the Lord. 3) The Lord has blessed the work of the hands of the faithful, and knoweth the steps of the faithful. He has blessed those who have gone forth among the people of all nations. Incline thy ear, and hear; open thy eyes that thou might see, and set thy heart to receive that which the Lord is speaking today.

15) Soon the Lord shall break in pieces the mighty men without number, and set others in their stead. The Lord shall strike them as wicked men in open sight of all men. Nations shall clamor for peace; yet there shall be no peace, even as the Lord hath warned you: the pale horse has been let to bring destruction upon destruction.

16) Hear ye the people of the Lord, thus saith the Lord, 'I say unto you that if were not for the prayers uttered by the righteous of the world, ye would even now be visited with utter destruction. It would have been for each of you as in the days of Noah, had not their prayers reaching up unto the courts of heaven, and His patience and Mercy been extended unto each of you.'
